

Fleetwood swimmers at the Lancashire Championships.

Twenty-two Fleetwood swimmers qualified for events at the Lancashire Championships, where the counties finest compete over 4 days, at the Manchester Aquatic Centre. They produced a fantastic combined total of 4 gold, 6 silver, 10 bronze, 62 pb's and 36 top 10 finishes.

Leading the way was 15yo Martha Hirst (pictured) who swam 6pbs and was rewarded with 3 gold, a silver and 2 bronze medals. She now has her sights well and truly set on the National Championships later in the year.

9 year old Thomas Manning (pictured) once again turned in a very accomplished set of swims to come away with a gold, 3 silver and 2 bronze medals. These 6pbs were enough to give him 2nd placed 9yo in the county!

Liam Sutcliffe had an exceptionally good championships having missed out last year through injury. He made up in fine style obtaining 10pbs, nine of which were top 10 finishes. He picked up 2 bronze medals and finished 8th overall in his age group.

Bradley Sharples swam 5pb's in picking up silver and 2 bronze medals. His 6 top 10 finishes were sufficient to get him 6th best 10yo in Lancashire. A result which may well have been bettered had he not missed the last day of the championships due to him competing in the National finals of the schools Biathlon in London.

Sixteen year old Jack Stanney again performed well with his 3 top 10 finishes gaining him silver and a bronze medal and a new pb.

Hannah Roe picked up a deserved bronze medal in the 10yo age group and set herself 4 new pb's.

William Eccleston and Tommy Humphries each obtained 4 pb's and 1 top 10 finish.

Phoebe Brown swam 3 pb's and was rewarded with a top 10 finish for her efforts.

Jack Hirst set 2 new pb's and obtained a top 10 finish whilst Alex Jones-Wright swam a pb which also gave him a finish inside the top 10.

Rebecca Williams set herself 4 new pb's. Gaby Davey and Ciara Barcock set 2 new pbs apiece.

Amy Butler, Charlotte Grogan, Callum Preece, Kyle Preece, Rebecca Robinson and Dom Roe all set a new pb each.
